Applicable to any type of photocell operated fixtures, either individual or multiple, operated from dusk to dawn.

In all areas within the District as now served. Subject to the requirements of the primary purposes of the District and the availability of power and energy in the opinion of the District.

**Type of Service:**

Single phase, 60 Hertz. Flat rate unmetered. Except as provided, District will own, maintain, and operate fixtures.

**Special conditions**

Basic installation includes up to 120 feet of secondary wire. Longer runs will be charged based on the additional length, type of conductor and necessity for installing additional support poles. Underground installations may require additional installation costs for trenching, concrete sawing or asphalt patching, etc. All charges that are beyond what are necessary for basic service (such as for additional interconnection, transformers, metering, or other equipment that are dedicated to the customer) shall be charged directly to the customer. All existing mercury vapor lamps will eventually be retro-fitted to high pressure sodium lamps.
